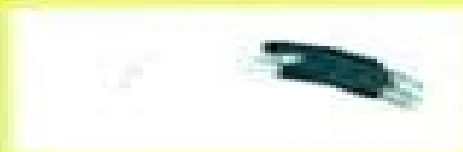

Daston, 2012-12-06 Having received the invitation from Springer Verlag to produce a volume on drug induced birth defects for the Handbook of Experimental Pharmacology we asked ourselves what new approach could we offer that would capture the state of the science and bring a new synthesis of the information on this topic to the world's literature. We chose a three pronged approach centered around those particular drugs for which we have a relatively well established basis for understanding how they exert their unwanted effects on the human embryo.
