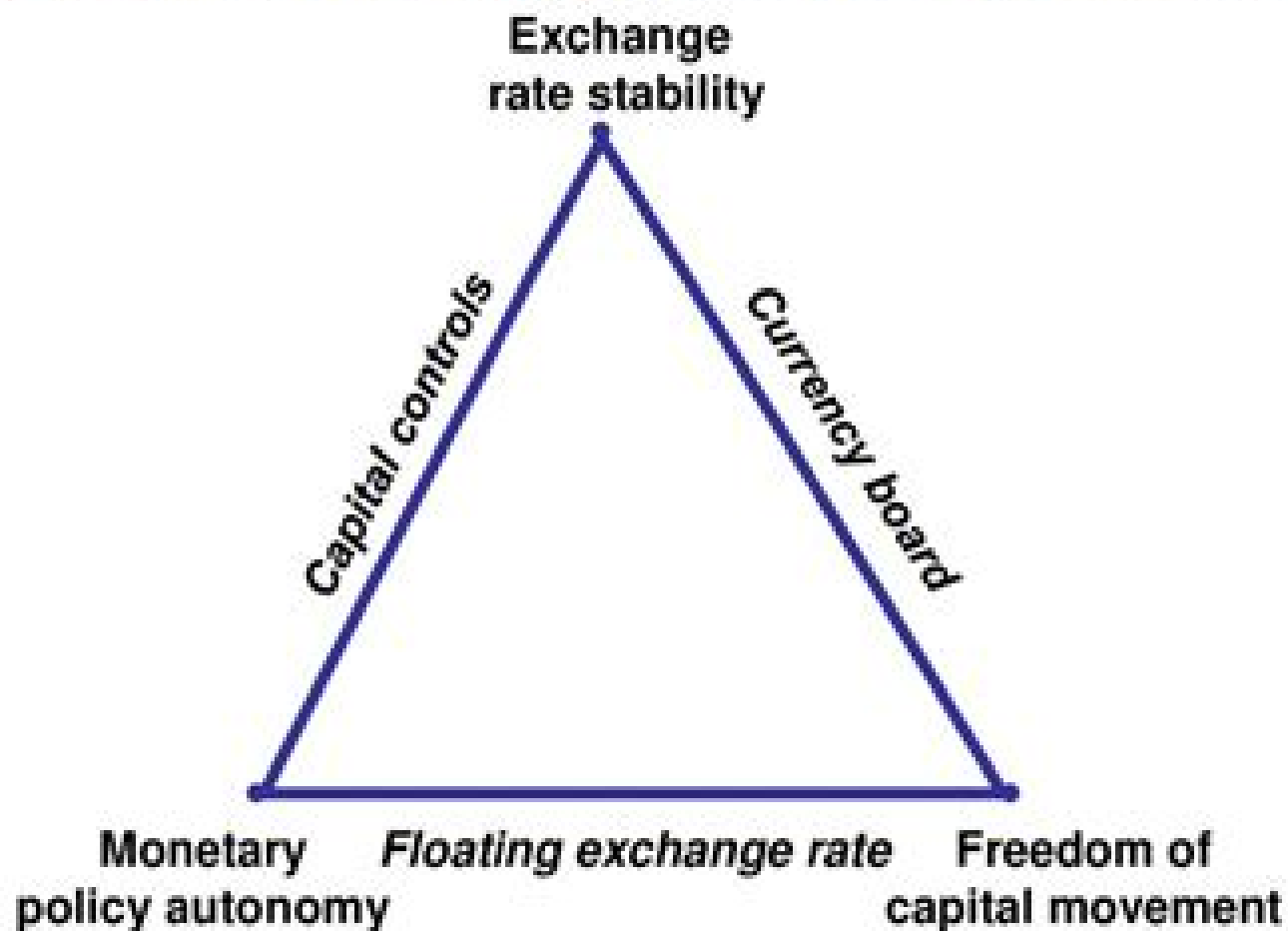


Figure 22-4: The Policy Trilemma for Open Economies
