The Struggle for Black Freedom in Miami Chanelle Nyree Rose,2015-05-18 Offering new insights into Florida's position within the cultural legacy of the South The Struggle for Black Freedom in Miami explores the long fight for civil rights in one of the country's most popular tourist destinations Chanelle N Rose examines how the sustained tourism and rapid demographic changes that characterized Miami for much of the twentieth century undermined constructions of blackness and whiteness that remained more firmly entrenched in other parts of the South The convergence of cultural practices in Miami from the American South and North the Caribbean and Latin America created a border community that never fit comfortably within the paradigm of the Deep South experience As white civic elites scrambled to secure the city's burgeoning reputation as the Gateway to the Americas an influx of Spanish speaking migrants and tourists had a transformative effect on conventional notions of blackness Business owners and city boosters resisted arbitrary racial distinctions and even permitted dark skinned Latinos access to public accommodations that were otherwise off limits to nonwhites in the South At the same time civil rights activists waged a fierce battle against the antiblack discrimination and violence that lay beneath the public image of Miami as a place relatively tolerant of racial diversity In its exploration of regional distinctions transnational forces and the effect of both on the civil rights battle The Struggle for Black Freedom in Miami complicates the black white binary and offers a new way of understanding the complexity of racial traditions and white supremacy in southern metropolises like Miami

But in this examination of the project and its legacy Catherine A Stewart shows it was the product of competing visions of the past as ex slaves memories of bondage emancipation and life as freedpeople were used to craft arguments for and against full inclusion of African Americans in society. Stewart demonstrates how project administrators such as the folklorist John Lomax white and black interviewers including Zora Neale Hurston and the ex slaves themselves fought to shape understandings of black identity. She reveals that some influential project employees were also members of the United Daughters of the Confederacy intent on memorializing the Old South. Stewart places ex slaves at the center of debates over black citizenship to illuminate African Americans struggle to redefine their past as well as their future in the face of formidable opposition. By shedding new light on a critically important episode in the history of race remembrance and the legacy of slavery in the United States Stewart compels readers to rethink a prominent archive used to construct that history.

Matthew Clavin recovers the story of fugitive slaves who sought freedom by paradoxically sojourning deeper into the American South toward an unlikely destination the small seaport of Pensacola Florida a gateway to freedom.

Folklore and Book Culture Kevin J. Hayes, 2016-02-05 To many observers folklore and book culture may appear to be opposites. Folklore after all involves orally circulated stories and traditions while book culture is concerned with the transmission of written texts. However as Kevin J Hayes points out there are many instances where the two intersect and exploring those intersections is the purpose of this fascinating and provocative study. Hayes shows that the acquisition of knowledge and the ownership of books have not displaced folklore but instead have given rise to new beliefs and superstitions. Some books have generated new proverbs others have fostered their own legends. Occasionally the book has served as an important motif in folklore and in one folk genre the flyleaf rhyme the book itself has become the place where folklore occurs thus indicating a lively interaction between folk print and manuscript culture. The author begins by examining the tradition of the Volksbucher cheaply printed books often concerned with the occult whose powers are said to transcend the written text. Hayes looks in depth at one

particular Volksbuch The Sixth and Seventh Books of Moses and proceeds in subsequent chapters to discuss a variety of folktales and legends placing them within the context of book culture and the history of education He closes with an examination of flyleaf rhymes the little verses that book owners have inscribed in their books and considers what they reveal about the identity of the inscribers as well as about attitudes toward book lending book borrowing and the circulation of knowledge Solidly researched and venturing into areas long neglected by scholars Folklore and Book Culture is a work that will engage not only folklorists but historians and literary scholars as well *Memories of the Enslaved* Spencer R.

Delius and the Sound of Place Daniel M.
