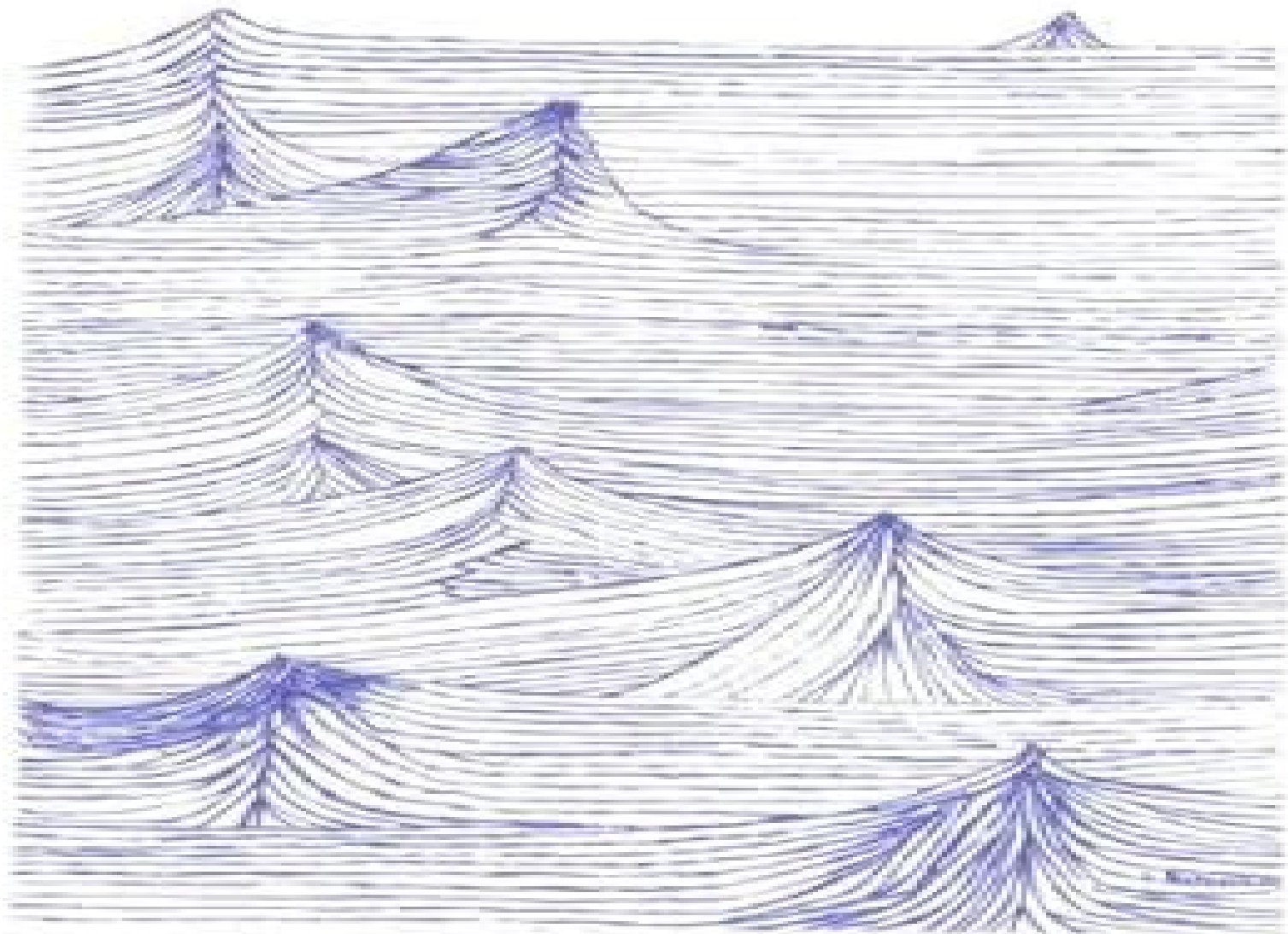

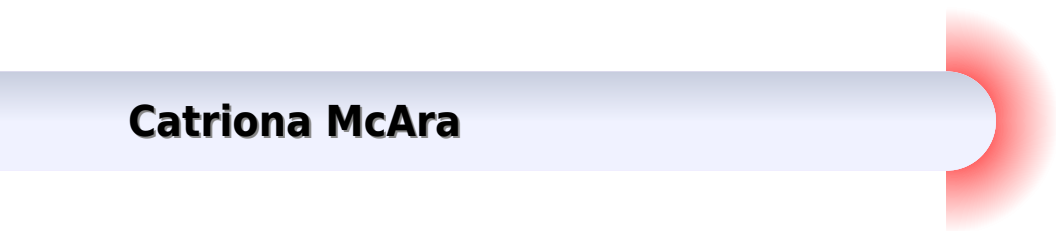

Art and Psychoanalysis Maria Walsh, 2012-11-20.
