Pacault, 2012-12-06 Markedly apart from elementary particle physics another current has been building up and continuously growing within contemporary physics for several decades and even expanding into many other disciplines especially chemistry biology and quite recently economics Several reasons account for this presumably the most important one lies in the fact that whatever the specific problem model or material concerned the same basic mathematical features are always involved In this way a general phenomenology has emerged which unlike thermodynamics is no longer dependent upon the details or specifics what largely prevails is the nonlinear character of the underlying dynamics Perhaps we are witnessing the emergence of a nonlinear physics In a way similar to the birth of quantum physics in the twenties a physics which deals with the general behaviour of systems whatever they are or may be Over the past fifteen years chemical systems evolving sufficiently far from equilibrium have proved to be particularly well fitted to experimental research on nonlinear behaviour oscillation multistability birhythmicity chaotic evolution spatial self organization and hysteresis are displayed by chemical reactions whose number is growing each year In this volume are collected the lectures communications and posters abstracts presented at an international meeting entitled Non Equilibrium Dynamics in Chemical Systems held in Bordeaux France September 3rd 1984

Far-from-equilibrium Dynamics of Chemical Systems J. Popielawski, 1991 Foundations of Synergetics I Alexander S. Mikhailov, 2012-12-06 This book gives an introduction to the mathematical theory of cooperative behavior in active systems of various origins both natural and artificial It is based on a lecture course in synergetics which I held for almost ten years at the University of Moscow The first volume deals mainly with the problems of pattern formation and the properties of self organized regular patterns in distributed active systems It also contains a discussion of distributed analog information processing which is based on the cooperative dynamics of active systems The second volume is devoted to the

stochastic aspects of self organization and the properties of self established chaos I have tried to avoid delving into particular applications The primary intention is to present general mathematical models that describe the principal kinds of cooperative behavior in distributed active systems Simple examples ranging from chemical physics to economics serve only as illustrations of the typical context in which a particular model can apply The manner of exposition is more in the tradition of theoretical physics than of in mathematics Elaborate formal proofs and rigorous estimates are often replaced the text by arguments based on an intuitive understanding of the relevant models Because of the interdisciplinary nature of this book its readers might well come from very diverse fields of endeavor It was therefore desirable to minimize the required preliminary knowledge Generally a standard university course in differential calculus and linear algebra is sufficient

Nonlinear Irreversible Processes Werner Ebeling, Heinz Ulbricht, 2012-12-06 These Proceedings contain invited lectures presented at the third International Conference on Irreversible Processes and Dissipative Structures in Kihlungsborn German Democratic Republic in March 1985 These conferences the first of which was held in Rostock in 1977 and the second in Berlin in 1982 are devoted to the study of irreversible processes far from thermal equilibrium and to the phenomena of selforganization The meeting in Kihlungsborn brought together some 160 mathematicians physicists chemists and biologists from 10 countries who are all interested in the interdisciplinary field of synergetics The main topics of the conference were basic concepts of selforganization and evolution such as entropy instabilities nucleation dissipative structures chaos and turbulence The contributions cover methods from thermodynamics the theory of dynamic systems stochastic and statistic theory the method of Green's functions the fluctuation dissipation theorem etc Several problems are studied in more detail e.g. the kinetics of nucleation especially in finite systems the dynamics of interfaces reaction diffusion systems chemical and biochemical pattern formation and information processing Further several contributions are devoted to the development of the concepts of chaos and turbulence The editors hope that the contributions collected in this volume will provide some new information about the field of selforganization which is in full development now

Dimensions and Entropies in Chaotic Systems Gottfried Mayer-Kress, 2012-12-06 These proceedings contain the papers contributed to the International Workshop on Dimensions and Entropies in Chaotic Systems at the Pecos River Conference Center on the Pecos River Ranch in September 1985 The workshop was held by the Center for Nonlinear Studies of the Los Alamos National Laboratory At the Center for Nonlinear Studies the investigation of chaotic dynamics and especially the quantification of complex behavior has a long tradition In spite of some remarkable successes there are fundamental as well as numerical problems involved in the practical realization of these algorithms This has led to a series of publications in which modifications and improvements of the original methods have been proposed At present there exists a growing number of competing dimension algorithms but no comprehensive review explaining how they are related Further in actual experimental applications rather than a precise algorithm one finds frequent use of rules of thumb together with error estimates which in many cases appear to be far too optimistic Also it seems that questions like What is the maximal dimension of an attractor that one can measure with a given number of data points and a given experimental resolution have still not been answered in a satisfactory manner for general cases

Chemical Waves and Patterns Raymond Kapral, K. Showalter, 2012-12-06 The concept of macroscopic waves and patterns developing from chemical reaction coupling with diffusion was presented apparently for the first time at the Main Meeting of the Deutsche Bunsengesellschaft für Angewandte Physikalische Chemie held in Dresden Germany from May 21 to 24 1906 Robert Luther Director of the Physical Chemistry Laboratory in Leipzig read his paper on the discovery and analysis of propagating reaction diffusion fronts in autocatalytic chemical reactions 1 2 He presented an equation for the velocity of these new waves $V = \frac{1}{2} \sqrt{KDC}$ and asserted

that they might have features in common with propagating action potentials in nerve cell axons During the discussion period a skeptic in the audience voiced his objections to this notion It was none other than the great physical chemist Walther Nernst who believed that nerve impulse propagation was far too rapid to be akin to the propagating fronts He was also not willing to accept Luther's wave velocity equation without a derivation Luther stood his ground saying his equation was a simple consequence of the corresponding differential equation He described several different autocatalytic reactions that exhibit propagating fronts recommending gelling the solution to prevent convection and even presented a demonstration the autocatalytic permanganate oxidation of oxalate was carried out in a test tube with the image of the front projected onto a screen for the audience

Dynamical Problems in Soliton Systems Shozo Takeno, 2013-03-14 This volume contains most of the papers presented in the oral session of the 7th Kyoto Summer Institute KSI on Dynamical Problems in Soliton Systems held in Kyoto from August 27 to 31 1984 Furthermore it contains contributions of R K Bullough H H Chen A S Davydov and N Sanchez who unfortunately could not attend Thirty six papers were presented in the oral session and 17 papers in the poster session The meeting brought together 109 physicists and mathematicians of which 22 were from abroad see group photograph The KSI is an international meeting organized by the Research Institute for Fundamental Physics RIFP Kyoto University to discuss various current problems of fundamental importance in theoretical physics The 7th KSI was the first international meeting on solitons in Japan Early in 1983 it was felt in the RIFP that the time was ripe for a conference dealing with problems concerning solitons The RIFP asked us to organize the conference The Organizing Committee consisted of R Hirota Hiroshima T Taniuti Nagoya Y H Ichikawa Nagoya M Toda Tokyo Z Maki Kyoto M Wadati Tokyo N Yajima Fukuoka S Takeno Kyoto Since its discovery the study of the soliton as a stable particle like state of nonlinear systems has caught the imagination of physicists and mathematicians

Nonlinear Fokker-Planck Equations T.D. Frank, 2005-01-07 Centered around the natural phenomena of relaxations and fluctuations this monograph provides readers with a solid foundation in the linear and nonlinear Fokker Planck equations that describe the evolution of distribution functions It emphasizes principles and notions of the theory e.g. self organization stochastic feedback free energy and Markov processes while also illustrating the wide applicability e.g. collective behavior multistability front dynamics and quantum particle distribution The focus is on relaxation processes in homogeneous many body systems describable by nonlinear Fokker Planck equations Also treated are Langevin equations and correlation functions Since these phenomena are exhibited by a diverse spectrum of systems examples and applications span the fields of physics biology and neurophysics mathematics psychology and biomechanics

based representation of this perceptual object by means of a synchronization mechanism feature binding In language processing it is shown how semantic concepts and syntactic roles can be dynamically related together or can be integrated to neurally based systematic and compositional connectionist representations by means of a synchronization mechanism variable binding solving the Fodor Pylyshyn Challenge Since the systemtheoretical connectionism has succeeded in modeling the sensory objects in perception as well as systematic and compositional representations in language processing with this vector and oscillation based representation format a new convincing theory of neurocognition has been developed which bridges the neuronal and the cognitive analysis level The book describes how elementary neuronal information is combined in perception and language so it becomes clear how the brain processes this information to enable basic cognitive performance of the humans

Information and Self-Organization Hermann Haken, 2013-11-11 Complex systems are ubiquitous and practically all branches of science ranging from physics through chemistry and biology to economics and sociology have to deal with them In this book we wish to present concepts and methods for dealing with complex systems from a unifying point of view Therefore it may be of interest to graduate students professors and research workers who are concerned with theoretical work in the above mentioned fields The basic idea for our unified approach stems from that of synergetics In order to find unifying principles we shall focus our attention on those situations where a complex system changes its macroscopic behavior qualitatively or in other words where it changes its macroscopic spatial temporal or functional structure Until now the theory of synergetics has usually begun with a microscopic or mesoscopic description of a complex system In this book we present an approach which starts out from macroscopic data In particular we shall treat systems that acquire their new structure without specific interference from the outside i e systems which are self organizing The vehicle we shall use is information Since this word has several quite different meanings all of which are important for our purpose we shall discuss its various aspects These range from Shannon information from which all semantics has been exorcised to the effects of information on receivers and the self creation of meaning
