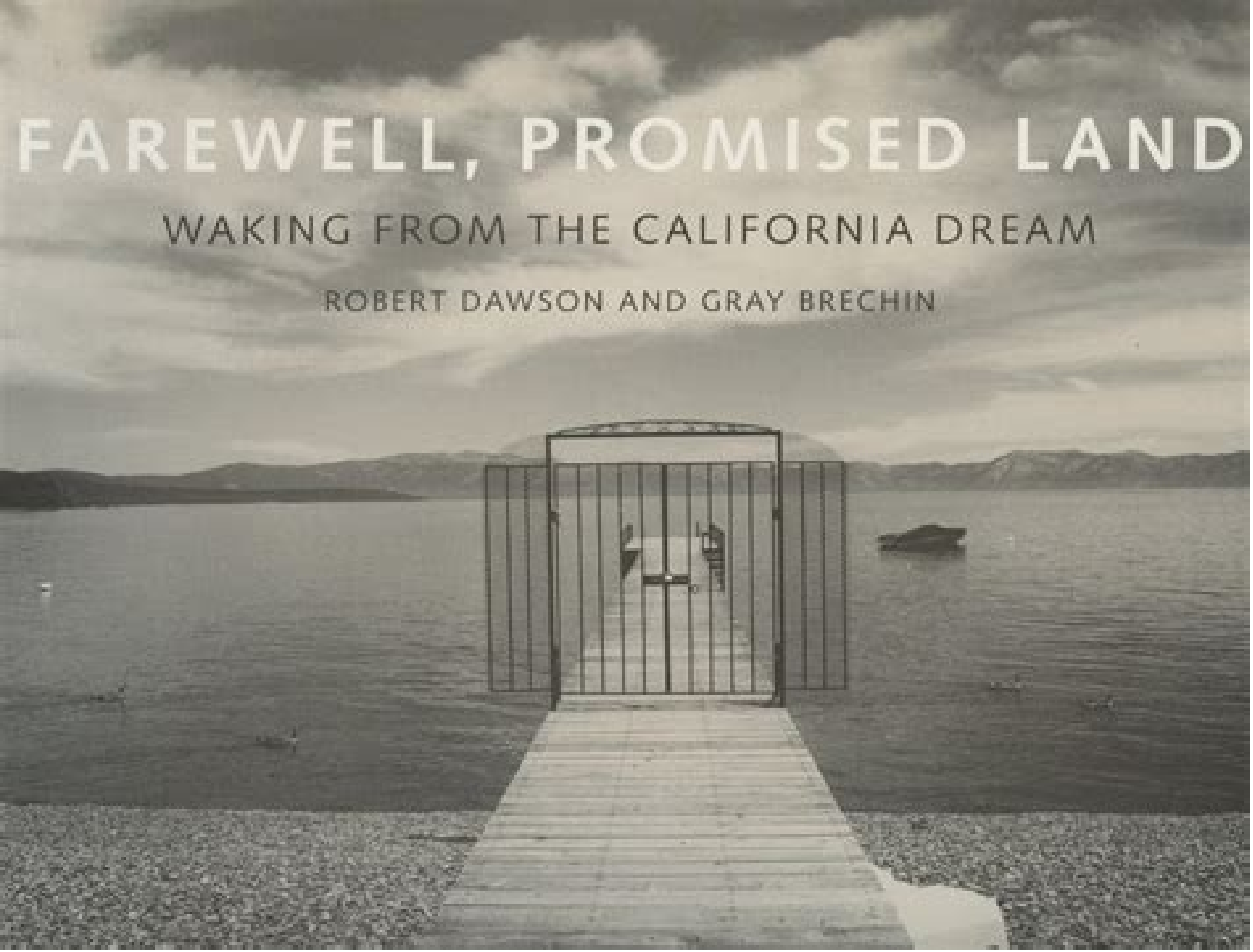

In text and photographs, *Farewell Promised Land* documents the stark contrast between the California landscape of this past and what it has become as it traces the evolution of the California environment and looks ahead to what the future holds. When writer Gray Brechin and photographer Robert Dawson received the 1992 Dorothea Lange-Paul Taylor Prize from Duke University's Center for Documentary Studies, they began a five-year project of driving and flying around California to record the present state of its environment.
