his theory from a conceptual point of view When compared to other subjects the area of health economics is differentiated by a number of features These elements include a significant engagement from the government intractable uncertainty in several dimensions asymmetric information impediments to entrance externality and the presence of a third party agent Within the context of the healthcare sector the patient's health insurer is referred to as a third party agent The entity that is responsible for bearing the financial obligation for the healthcare goods and services that are used by the insured patient is the business that is known as the health insurer A number of different types of financial information such as expenditures charges and costs are assessed within the realm of health economics
