- ◆ Carl von Clausewitz prophesied the emergence of "total war," but most historians regard the First World War as the first "total war" for these four reasons:
 1. Economic: industrial warfare by huge conscript armies demanded the reorganization of the whole economy.
 2. Psychological: combat became utterly terrifying, with a killing zone over 5 miles deep; "shell shock" became a major source of casualties.
 3. Social psychological: massive propaganda campaigns demonized the enemy in each country.
 4. Ethical: hunger blockades, bombardments, and anti-partisan actions broke down the distinction between combatants & noncombatants.

In 1916 combat reached maximum intensity in the Battles of Verdun & the Somme, and the Brusilov Offensive....

The Age of Total War, 1860-1945 Jeremy M. Black, 2006-03-31 What is total war Definitions abound but one thing is certain the concept of total war has come to be seen as a defining concept of the modern age Celebrated historian Jeremy Black explores the rise and demise of an era of total war which he defines in terms of the intensity of the struggle the range geographical and or chronological of conflict the nature of the goals and the extent to which civil society was involved He contends that this era roughly 1860 1945 was markedly different from the warfare that characterized earlier periods and that it is very different from the situation that has evolved since with its emphasis on asymmetrical conflict and limited warfare Acknowledging that various definitions are problematic and often contradictory Black argues that 1860 to 1945 was an era in which the prospect of war and the consequences of it were crucially important for human history He focuses primarily on conflict between Western powers including Japanese participation in the Russo Japanese War Trends and developments subsequent to 1945 have combined Black asserts to make a return to total war unlikely

So global military history is actually the triumphal story of the West from Classical Greece onwards This volume focuses not only on the eastern part of Eurasia but also on South America Africa and Australasia and seeks to explain the history and varied trajectories of warfare in non Western regions in the pre modern era Further it evaluates whether warfare in non Western regions should be considered primitive or inferior when compared with Western warfare The book notes that Western Europe became militarily significant only in the early modern era and argues that the military divergence that occurred during the early modern era is not unique it had also occurred in the Bronze Age the Classical era and in the medieval period This was due to the dynamism and innovativeness of non Western militaries and the interconnectedness that existed in parts of the Eurasian landmass Further those polities which were able to construct a balanced military force by synthesising diverse elements were not only able to survive but also became capable of projecting power across continents This book will be of much interest to students of military history strategic studies and world history
