Check patient

Signs of SCA

- ▶ Unconscious
- ▶ Not breathing
- ▶ No circulation (no pulse)



If victim is unresponsive, activate the chain of survival; a series of steps and procedures, which together could save the life of a sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) victim.

1

Call for help



Stay with the victim; send someone to CALL 911 and return with the AED.

2

Start CPR



Begin CPR immediately to circulate oxygenated blood to the brain and body. As soon as the AED arrives, use it.

3

Early Defibrillation



1. Turn on AED
2. Follow audible instructions
3. Press the shock button, if advised.

4

Advanced Care



Have someone direct the paramedics to the scene and update them on the status of the victim.



Act Fast!

SCA is the leading cause of death in the United States. The risk of death is highest when defibrillation is delayed. Every minute that passes after the victim has collapsed, the risk of death increases by 10%.

Importance of CPR

Without CPR, the victim's heart will stop. CPR can keep the blood flowing to the brain and body, giving the victim a better chance to respond to defibrillation therapy.

AEDs Are Safe

AEDs are safe and easy to use. They will only deliver a shock if the victim is in cardiac arrest. AEDs are designed to be used by anyone, even someone who has never used one before. AEDs are safe and effective, and they can save lives.



Notice where AEDs are located.

A sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) is a life-threatening condition that can occur without warning. Knowing how to respond quickly can increase the victim's chance of survival.
