**It's Nation Time** Jerry White,2024-10-01 Speaking at the Congress of African People in September 1970 Amiri Baraka said In Newark when we greet each other on the streets we say what time is it We always say It s nation time Nationalism is about land and nation a way of life trying to free itself National identity and

nationhood are too often easily dismissed as retrograde populism or racist exclusion. Instead, they need to be understood as a key part of a vision of globalization that holds the imperatives of diversity and solidarity in a delicate balance. Jerry White offers a defence of the nation based on the assumption that struggles for national identity have often unfolded in ways that should be familiar to those who defend the political standpoint of the progressive left. Having evolved into something that a wide variety of actors have sought to defend, nations can also serve as a defence against the homogenizing forces of globalization and as havens of diversity in opposition to more singularly minded forms of affiliation. **Soundin' Canaan** Paul db Watkins, 2025-01-21. Part exploration of a key group of Black Canadian poets, part literary, cultural, and musical history, *Soundin' Canaan* demonstrates how music in Black Canadian poetry is not solely aesthetic but a form of social, ethical, and political expression. *Soundin' Canaan* refers to the code name often used for Canada during the Black migration to Canada. The book analyzes the contributions of key Black Canadian poets, including their poetic styles and their performances. The book has several key objectives, including recuperating the collision of the historical and the Biblically derived figure of Canaan, the promised land of freedom and security for an African American population seeking to leave the shackles of slavery behind, and the northern terminus of the underground railroad. Centering around the poetry of George Elliott Clarke, Dionne Brand, M. NourbeSe Philip, Wayde Compton, and rapper Knaan, it delves into how these poets draw inspiration from African American and Afro-diasporic musical genres such as blues, jazz, reggae, and dub, hip hop, and remix to reshape the notions of identity and citizenship. *Soundin' Canaan* asks what does Canadian citizenship sound like, especially when voiced by Black Canadian poets who embrace a fluid and multicultural form of citizenship that moves between local and global spaces, much like music does. Using a DJ Methodology, the author mixes in close readings of poetry, music, cultural, and literary history, as well as various
