Mr Webb quotes to support his thesis What history in his hands proves is 1 that private competition is often disastrous 2 that a State regulation or State annexation of a particular branch of industry may under some circumstances be preferable 3 that in all these cases the State or subordinate governing body has held itself bound to consult the interest of the consumer
