Despite intense pressure from her peers to conform to their theories, Reichard held firm to her humanitarian principles and methods; the result, as Nancy Mattina makes clear, was pathbreaking work in the ethnography of ritual and mythology. Wiyot, Coeur d'Alene and Navajo linguistics, folk art, gender and language, amplified by an exceptional career of teaching, editing, publishing and mentoring. Drawing on Reichard's own writings and correspondence, this book provides an intimate picture of her small-town upbringing, the professional challenges she faced in male-centered institutions and her quietly revolutionary contributions to anthropology. Gladys Reichard emerges as she lived and worked: a far-sighted, self-reliant humanist sustained in turbulent times by the generous egalitarian spirit that called her yearly to the far corners of the American West.
