with better controls have a stronger relationship with improvements in perceptions of corruption compared to PFM reforms associated with more transparency The last chapter looks at the relationship between PEFA indicators for revenue administration and domestic resource mobilization It focuses on the credible use of penalties for noncompliance as a proxy for the type of political commitment required to improve tax performance.
