from scriptural language Chapter 6 places Yeats in the broad context of biblical intertextuality working backward from modernism to Romanticism First the study contrasts Yeats with two of his contemporaries D H Lawrence and T S Eliot for whom the Bible always asserts its religious authority in the Victorian tradition of Arnold Clough Browning and Tennyson The study concludes by comparing Yeats to Wordsworth and Shelley Although Yeats is deeply indebted to them his attitude is distinct from theirs even when rejecting the Bible Wordsworth and Shelley accept a dogmatic view of it while Yeats escapes dogmatism
