- → 1949: Prime Ministers' Meeting, allowing republics to keep the British monarch as head of the Commonwealth, 'as the symbol of the free association of independent member nations and as such Head of the Commonwealth' <u>BUT NOT</u> AS HEAD OF THEIR STATE
