Good Son is Sad If He Hears the Name of His Father Piotr Adamek,2017-07-05 When in 1775 the scholar Wang Xihou compiled a dictionary called Ziguan he wrote for illustrative purposes the personal names of Confucius and the three emperors Kangxi Yongzheng and Qianlong in the introduction In oversight he recorded their complete names This accidental writing of a few names was condemned by Emperor Qianlong as an unprecedented
