For as an advocate, Bizos is associated with the Treason Trial of the late 1950s, the subsequent Rivonia Trial where his colleague, client, and friend Nelson Mandela was sentenced to life imprisonment, the trial of Bram Fischer, that of the Namibian Toivo ja Toivo, a host of major human rights trials through the 1970s and 1980s, right up to the amnesty hearings of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, and in 2004, with the treason trial of the Zimbabwean opposition leader Morgan Tsvangirai in that country.
