They retitled the work THE FANTASTICKS based upon an English translation of the original French *Les Romanesques*.

Jones recalled that Payne had taught him about the presentational style of the theatre of Shakespeare...so they decided to "do all the things we always wanted to do, celebrating the restrictions of the theatre and its artificiality, rather than trying to disguise it in any way."



Lore Noto, a young producer saw the one-act version and offered to produce it off-Broadway. He gave the writers an advance of \$250 and purchased the rights for \$500 plus 6% of the gross and began the task of raising a production budget of \$16,500
