Jamaica is the first CARICOM member state to establish an independent regulatory body to ensure the safe and secure operation of facilities using ionising radiation and nuclear technology. It includes the 20 kW SLOWPOKE research reactor, which is the only nuclear reactor in Caribbean. The 2015 Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection Act is a comprehensive piece of legislation that the Authority is tasked with enforcing. The Act addresses all aspects of nuclear safety and security, including safeguards and civil liability in the event of nuclear harm. The Agency gives Jamaica the legal footing it needs to enact the international legal instruments that have been adopted by the Agency. The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Legislative Assistance Programme was instrumental in the drafting of the Act and the IAEA has endorsed and approved the 2019 Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection Regulations, and the Hazardous Substances Regulatory Authority (HSRA) is responsible for their implementation. As the use of nuclear science and technology spreads to new fields including nuclear medicine, radiotherapy, irradiation facilities, HSRA and the legislative and regulatory framework will ensure the safety of workers, the public, and the environment.

### The Jamaican SLOWPOKE-2 research reactor (JM-1)

The Jamaican SLOWPOKE-2 research reactor (JM-1) is a pool-type reactor designed by Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd (AECL). With a nominal thermal power rating of 20 kW at power, it is powered by around 6 kg of uranium enriched to 19.86% <sup>235</sup>U. As of its inception, JM-1 has been operating out of ICENS, the International Centre for Environmental Nuclear Sciences. The University of the West Indies Mona Campus is home to the 38-year ICENS, a complex of multidisciplinary research laboratories. Multidisciplinary environmental research is at the heart of ICENS' mission, as are the provision of answers to developmental issues and the promotion of the creation and maintenance of a highly qualified scientific
