The Jamaican SLOWPOKE-2 research reactor (JM-1) is a pool-type reactor designed by Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd (AECL). With a nominal thermal power rating of 20 kW at power, it is powered by around 6 kg of uranium enriched to 19.86% 235U. As of its 1 inception, JM-1 has been operating out of ICENS, the International Centre for Environmental Nuclear Sciences. The University of the West Indies Mona Campus is home to the 38-year ICENS, a complex of multidisciplinary research laboratories.
