The Economy of Prostitution in the Roman World Thomas McGinn, 2010-03-25 In recent years a number of classical scholars have turned their attention to prostitution in the ancient world. Close examination of the social and legal position of Roman meretrices and Greek hetairai have enriched our understanding of ancient sexual relationships and the status of women in these societies. These studies have focused however almost exclusively on the legal and literary evidence. McGinn approaches the issues from a new direction by studying the physical venues that existed for the sale of sex in the context of the Roman economy. Combining textual and material evidence he provides a detailed study of Roman brothels and other venues of venal sex from imperial palaces and private houses to taverns, circuses and back alleys, focusing on their forms, functions and urban locations. The book covers the central period of Roman history roughly from 200 B.C. to A.D. 250.
