

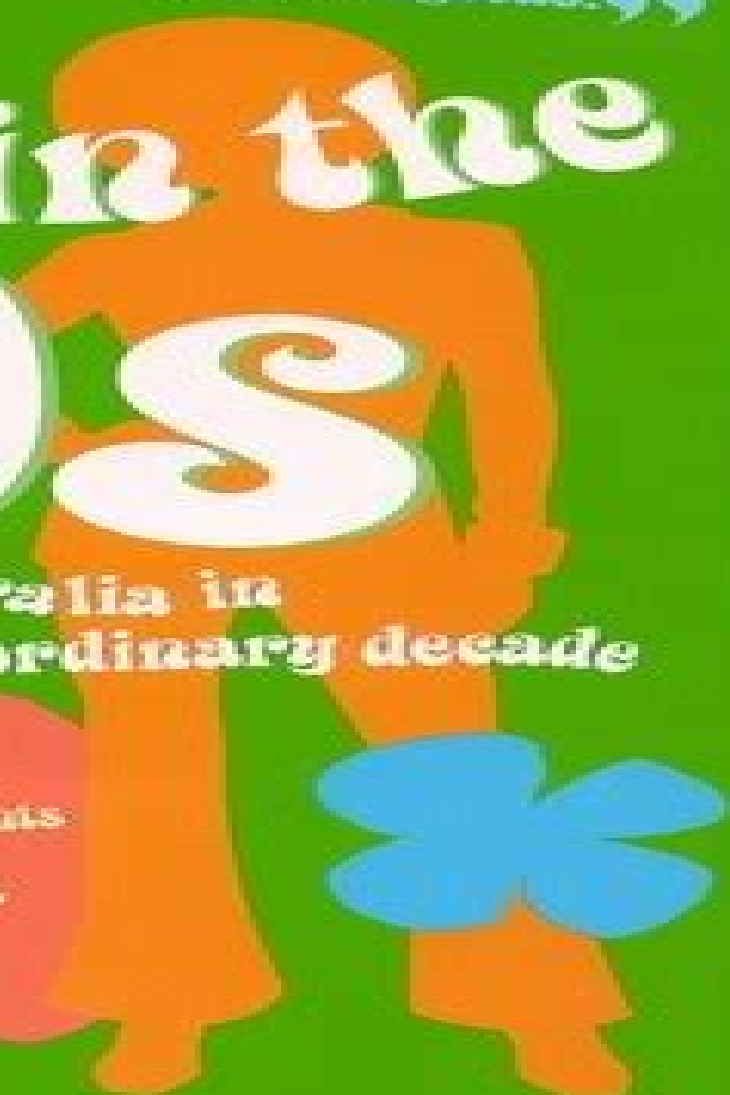

overcame the loss of their homeland through their version of a future Russia one transformed into a new society where their ideals could be realized When two generations later Lenin returned to Russia after decades in Europe and made this vision a reality his actions built on the foundation laid by his nineteenth century predecessors
