Violence-Supportive Cognition and Implicit Theories in Aggressive and Violent Behaviors: Implications for Violent Extremism

What goes through the minds of violent offenders when they exhibit aggressive and violent behaviors? How are they able to use violence while being aware of the harm caused by their actions? Do they genuinely believe violence can be an appropriate mean to an end? Such questions about the role of cognition in aggressive and violent behaviors are central in criminology and forensic psychology (Gannon Ward, Beech, & Fisher, 2007). Offense-supportive attitudes, including violence-supportive cognition, are a criminological need with one of the strongest effect sizes in the Risk-Need-Responsivity model of offender rehabilitation (Andrews & Bonta, 2010) and are therefore an important treatment target in violent offender rehabilitation programs (Polaschek & Collie, 2004; Polaschek, Calvert, & Gannon, 2009). In this chapter, we aim to highlight the relevance of violence-supportive cognition and their underlying cognitive structures—the implicit theories—in violent extremism. Specifically, we assume that violent extremism is a special case of violent behavior rather than a fundamentally different entity—which does not preclude the existence of specific features. Violence-supportive cognition is posited to play a similar role in violent extremism and is therefore an important assessment and treatment target when working with violent extremists.

OFFENSE- AND VIOLENCE-SUPPORTIVE COGNITION: THEORETICAL BACKGROUND

Analysis of cognition is a central topic in the study of criminal behaviors (Banse Koppehele-Gossel, Kistemaker, Werner, & Schmidt, 2013). In criminology, Sykes and Matza (1957) were among the first authors to highlight the role of rationalizations and justifications in the etiology of criminal

Social Work and the Psychosocial Journey Out of Far-Right Extremism Danny W. Carroll II, 2025-09-03. Over the last 30 years, domestic far-right extremism has risen to become the greatest threat to peace and safety in the United States. In the last few years alone, racialized, minoritized, and marginalized individuals and communities have been increasingly forced to feel the pain and experience the consequences of domestic far-right terrorism. Supposing academics, community leaders, and elected officials seek to combat the rising threat of far-right extremism in the United States, a greater focus must be paid to the lived experiences of men and women seeking to exit extremist groups. This study aimed to better understand the psychosocial processes involved in the disengagement and/or de-radicalization journey of former far-right extremists. Additionally, this study sought to understand better the potential role social work could play in the disengagement and de-radicalization of far-right extremists seeking to exit a life of hate and extremism. A constructivist-grounded theory approach provided the framework for this qualitative study. Semi-structured interviews with 19 former white nationalist extremists recruited through community informants and snowball sampling were used to answer the research question: What are the psychosocial processes involved in the disengagement and de-radicalization journey of former far-right extremists, and how do they develop in society? To date, there has not been a study located utilizing constructivist-grounded theory in disengagement and de-radicalization studies. Additionally, a theory of disengagement and de-radicalization has yet to be explored. This study sought to explore and conceptualize latent social patterns and structures within the disengagement

and de radicalization journey as a means to construct a theoretical frame to better understand one's journey from a life of hate. Study findings emerged from over 3 500 coded items from 18 transcripts. Eight themes emerged from the data and a theoretical model conceptualizing the psychosocial processes involved in the journey out of far right extremism is introduced.
