paradigm has been attacked and defended certain issues have remained in the forefront Kreyling takes on three reconciling the imperatives of race with the traditional definitions of the South testing the ways white women writers of the South have negotiated space within or outside the paradigm and analyzing the critics use and abuse of William Faulkner the major figure of southern literature as they have relied on his achievement to anchor the total project called Southern Literature
