素朴な疑問として、Hardy のそれも後期の小説には何故あのように古典や様々の芸術、哲学、自然科学などのアルージョンが多いのであろうか? これを単なる知識のひけらかしと見る Robert Gittings (Young Thomas Hard) などの考え方に対して、本書の著者 J. B. Bullen は全く反対の立場を取る。彼は冒頭の素朴な疑問に直接答える代わりに、Hardy の特に絵画を中心とした視覚芸術とのかかわりを通して、一見雑多で錯綜したアルージョンの意味を探りながら、この作家の登饒な小説世界を解明しようとする。本書はそうした作業から生まれた極めて示唆に富む研究書である。

Hardy の小説における絵画的特徴や映画的技法については、すでに J. Hillis Miller の Distance and Desire, Norman Page の Thomas Hardy, Joan Grundy の Hardy and the Sister Arts, David Lodge の Working with Structuralism 所取の Hardy に関する論文など、多くの優れた研究がある。Bullen は先人達の業績を批判的に引用したり、活用しながら自己の論を展開する。その時彼が不満に思うのは、今までの研究が Hardy の作品に現われた視覚芸術の作品を検証して断片的に対応関係を指摘したり、類似点や典拠を整理したりする仕事にのみ限られていたという点である。こうした Bullen の指摘はMiller や Lodge の研究の成果を知れば、必ずしも賛同し兼る所がある。ちなみに、この両者の上記の本を Bullen は少なくとも直接本書で参考にした形態はない。
