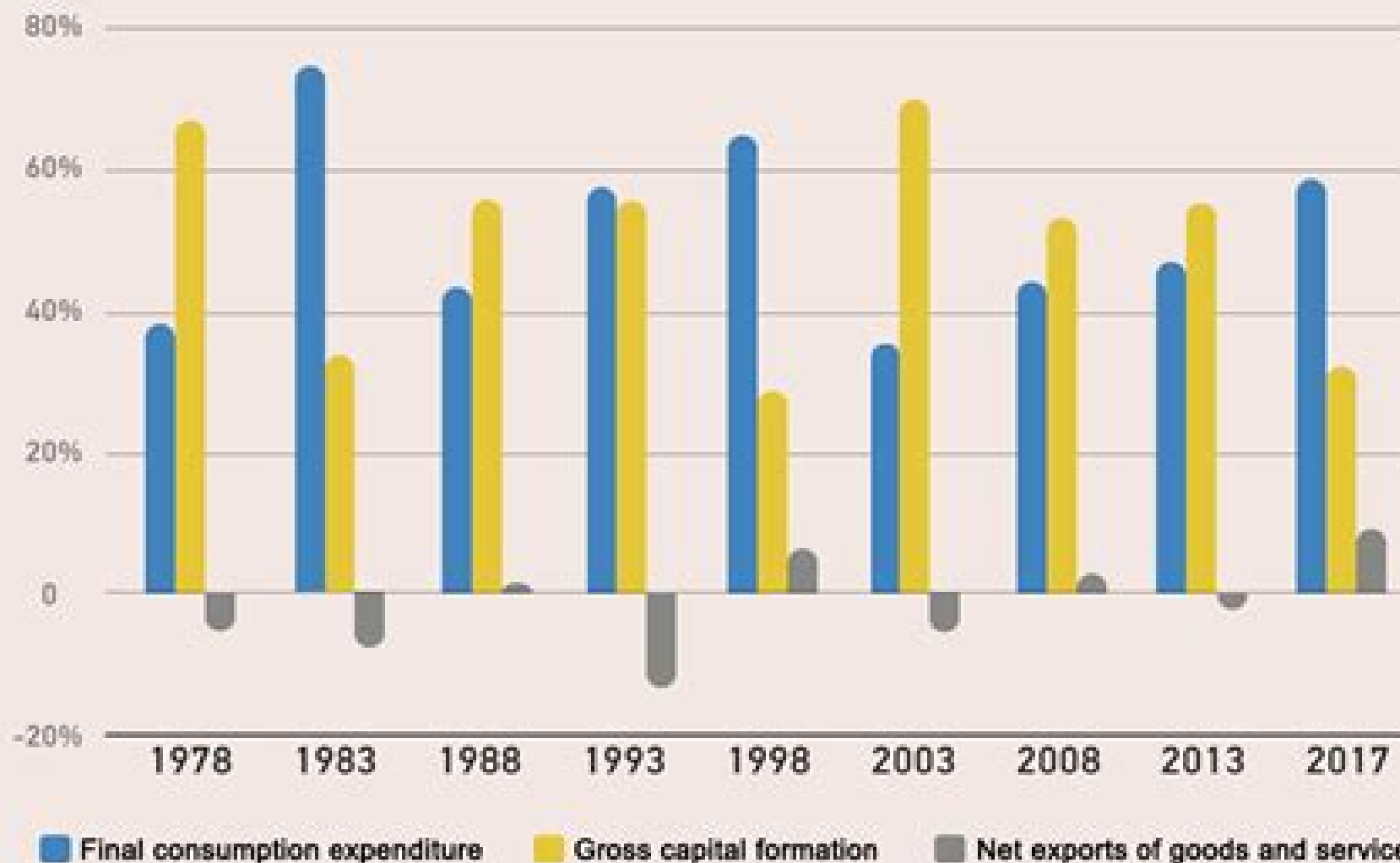


Percentage contribution to China's GDP growth
