For him, it is not a matter of a simple defence of a liberal system of society as may sometimes appear from the popularized versions of his thinking. Four indirect tests suggest that free-market economists have, in other instances, and presumably for fund-raising motives, suppressed embarrassing knowledge which suggests that they were perfectly capable of suppressing knowledge about Hayek's non-prediction of the Great Depression. With respect to the Nobel Prize, and thus his ability to reach a wider audience, Hayek was fortunate in having two loyal intermediaries, Lionel Robbins and Fritz Machlup, who were, and probably felt themselves to be, socially inferior to von Hayek. **Richard F.
