

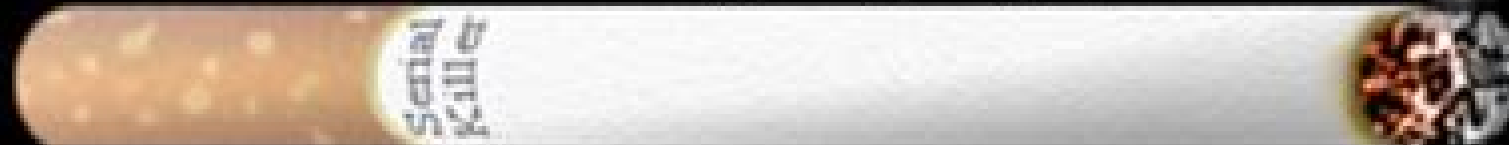

How do individuals perceive their own health risks? What is the effect of the addicting properties of nicotine on the behaviour of a rational utility maximizing individual?
