intermittent fasting IF on the welfare of young broiler breeders as well as wild type Red Junglefowl Intermittent fasting or skip a day feeding is supposedly the most common feeding strategy for broiler breeders worldwide but is perceived as welfare reducing and thus illegal in Sweden and several other European countries In spite of this the scientific knowledge of how this type of feeding affects chicken welfare is scarce Assessing the overall effect of IF on breeder welfare is complicated by large variations in both physiological and behavioral parameters between feeding and fasting days but it does appear that chicken welfare is improved at least on the feeding days of IF regimens It also seems that some of the health benefits reported from mammalian studies of IF may apply to chickens as well although behavioral indicators still point to welfare issues unless the level of feed restriction can be relaxed In comparison with daily feed restriction IF appears to increase the motivation for feed consumption but to reduce the motivation for appetitive behaviors such as foraging which may explain why birds fed on this type of schedule are often reported as calmer Animal Behavior Michael D.
