

Magic Carpet Exodus of Yemenite Jewry Esther Meir-Glitzenstein, 2014-07-15 In 1949 50 Operation Magic Carpet brought the majority of the Jews of Yemen to Israel through secret co operation between the Imam of Yemen the British colonial rulers of Aden the Israeli Government and the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee JDC In order to immigrate to Israel Yemenite Jews sold or abandoned their property took their sacred books with them and set out on foot trekking many difficult and treacherous kilometres to reach the southern border of Yemen and cross into Aden When they
