**On Sacred Ground** Nicholas O'Connell, 2011-10-01 *On Sacred Ground* explores the literature of the Northwest the area that extends from the Pacific Ocean to the Rocky Mountains and from the forty ninth parallel to the Siskiyou Mountains The Northwest exhibits astonishing geographical diversity and yet the entire bioregion shares a similarity of climate flora and fauna For Nicholas O'Connell the effects of nature on everyday Northwest life carry over to the region's literature Although Northwest writers address a number of subjects the relationship between people and place proves the dominant one and that has been true since the first tribes settled the region and began telling stories about it thousands of years ago Indeed it is the common thread linking Chief Seattle to Theodore Roethke Narciissa Whitman to Ursula K Le Guin Joaquin Miller to Ivan Doig Marilynne Robinson to Jack London Betty MacDonald to Gary Snyder Tracing the history of Pacific Northwest literary works from Native American myths to the accounts of explorers and settlers the effusions of the romantics the sharply etched stories of the realists the mystic visions of Northwest poets and the contemporary explosion of Northwest poetry and prose O'Connell shows how the most important contribution of Northwest writers to American literature is their articulation of a more spiritual human relationship with landscape Pacific Northwest writers and storytellers see the Northwest not just as a source of material wealth but as a spiritual homeland a place to lead a rich and fulfilling life within the whole context of creation And just as the relationship between people and place serves as the unifying feature of Northwest literature so also does literature itself possess a perhaps unique ability to transform a landscape into a sacred place

**Born in Seattle** Robert Sadamu Shimabukuro, 2013-05-01 The story of the World War II

internment of 120 000 Japanese American citizens and Japanese born permanent residents is well known by now Less well known is the history of the small group of Seattle activists who gave birth to the national movement for redress It was they who first conceived of petitioning the U S Congress to demand a public apology and monetary compensation for the individuals and the community whose constitutional rights had been violated Robert Sadamu Shimabukuro using hundreds of interviews with people who lived in the internment camps and with people who initiated the campaign for redress has constructed a very personal testimony a monument to these courageous organizers determination and deep reverence for justice Born in Seattle follows these pioneers and their movement over more than two decades starting in the late 1960s with second generation Japanese American engineers at the Boeing Company as they worked with their fellow activists to educate Japanese American communities legislative bodies and the broader American public about the need for the U S Government to acknowledge and pay for this wartime injustice and to promise that it will never be repeated *Letters from the 442nd* Minoru Masuda,2011-07-01 This is the first collection of letters by a member of the legendary 442nd Combat Team which served in Italy and France during World War II Written to his wife by a medic serving with the segregated Japanese American unit the letters describe a soldier s daily life Minoru Masuda was born and raised in Seattle In 1939 he earned a master s degree in pharmacology and married Hana Koriyama Two years later the Japanese struck Pearl Harbor and Min and Hana were imprisoned along with thousands of other Japanese Americans When the Army recruited in the relocation camp Masuda chose to serve in the 442nd In April 1944 the unit was shipped overseas They fought in Italy and in France where they liberated Bruyeres and rescued a lost battalion that had been cut off by the Germans After the German surrender on May 3 1945 Masuda was among the last of the original volunteers to leave Europe he arrived home on New Year s Eve 1945 Masuda s vivid and lively letters portray his surroundings his daily activities and the people he encountered He describes Italian farmhouses olive groves and avenues of cypress trees he writes of learning to play the ukulele with his big clumsy fingers and the nightly singing and bull sessions which continued throughout the war he relates the plight of the Italians who scavenged the 442nd s garbage for food and the mischief of French children who pelted the medics with snowballs Excerpts from the 442nd daily medical log provide context for the letters and Hana interposes brief recollections of her experiences The letters are accompanied by snapshots a drawing made in the field and three maps drawn by Masuda *Growing Up Brown* Peter M. Jamero, Sr.,2011-09-01 I may have been like other boys but there was a major difference my family included 80 to 100 single young men residing in a Filipino farm labor camp It was as a campo boy that I first learned of my ancestral roots and the sometimes tortuous path that Filipinos took in sailing halfway around the world to the promise that was America It was as a campo boy that I first learned the values of family community hard work and education As a campo boy I also began to see the two faces of America a place where Filipinos were at once welcomed and excluded were considered equal and were discriminated against It was a place where the values of fairness and freedom often fell short when Filipinos

put them to the test Peter Jamero Peter Jamero's story of hardship and success illuminates the experience of what he calls the bridge generation the American born children of the Filipinos recruited as farm workers in the 1920s and 30s Their experiences span the gap between these early immigrants and those Filipinos who owe their U S residency to the liberalization of immigration laws in 1965 His book is a sequel of sorts to Carlos Bulosan's *America Is in the Heart* with themes of heartbreaking struggle against racism and poverty and eventual triumph Jamero describes his early life in a farm labor camp in Livingston California and the path that took him through naval service and graduate school far beyond Livingston A longtime community activist and civic leader Jamero describes decades of toil and progress before the Filipino community entered the sociopolitical mainstream He shares a wealth of anecdotes and reflections from his career as an executive of health and human service programs in Sacramento Washington D C Seattle and San Francisco

**Imprisoned Apart** Louis Fiset, 2012-01-01 Please don't cry wrote Iwao Matsushita to his wife Hanaye telling her he was to be interned for the duration of the war He was imprisoned in Fort Missoula Montana and she was incarcerated at the Minidoka Relocation Center in southwestern Idaho Their separation would continue for more than two years *Imprisoned Apart* is the poignant story of a young teacher and his bride who came to Seattle from Japan in 1919 so that he might study English language and literature and who stayed to make a home On the night of December 7 1941 the FBI knocked at the Matsushita's door and took Iwao away first to jail at the Seattle Immigration Station and then by special train windows sealed and guards at the doors to Montana He was considered an enemy alien potentially dangerous to public safety because of his Japanese birth and professional associations The story of Iwao Matsushita's determination to clear his name and be reunited with his wife and of Hanaye Matsushita's growing confusion and despair unfolds in their correspondence presented here in full Their cards and letters most written in Japanese some in English when censors insisted provided us with the first look at life inside Fort Missoula one of the Justice Department's wartime camp for enemy aliens Because Iwao was fluent in both English and Japanese his communications are always articulate even lyrical if restrained Hanaye communicated briefly and awkwardly in English more fully and openly in Japanese Fiset presents a most affecting human story and helps us to read between the lines to understand what was happening to this gentle sensitive pair Hanaye suffered the emotional torment of disruption and displacement from everything safe and familiar Iwao a scholarly man who despite his imprisonment did not falter in his commitment to his adopted country suffered the ignominy of suspicion of being disloyal After the war he worked as a subject specialist at the

University of Washington's Far Eastern Library and served as principal of Seattle's Japanese Language School faithful to the Japanese American community until his death in 1979

**Altered Lives, Enduring Community** Stephen S. Fugita,Marilyn Fernandez,2011-10-01 Altered Lives Enduring Community examines the long-term effects on Japanese Americans of their World War II experiences forced removal from their Pacific Coast homes incarceration in desolate government camps and ultimate resettlement As part of Seattle's Densho Japanese American Legacy Project the authors collected interviews and survey data from Japanese Americans now living in King County Washington who were imprisoned during World War II Their clear-eyed often poignant account presents the contemporary post-redress perspectives of former incarcerated on their experiences and the consequences for their life course Using descriptive material that personalizes and contextualizes the data the authors show how prewar socioeconomic networks and the specific characteristics of the incarceration experience affected Japanese American readjustment in the postwar era Topics explored include the effects of incarceration and resettlement on social relationships and community structure educational and occupational trajectories marriage and

childbearing and military service and draft resistance The consequences of initial resettlement location and religious orientation are also examined **Quiet Odyssey** Mary Paik Lee,1990 In this moving testament Lee shares with her readers her feelings of growing up poor Asian and female Her story begins in Pyongyang Korea as part of a Christian family in the well to do upper class With the occupation of Korea by the Japanese in 1905 the social station and comfort of her family was threatened Thus they immigrated to America so that one part of the Paik family line would be preserved Chan s introduction provides a concise and comprehensive review that helps place the author s life history within its global context Three appendixes shed light on her role as a historiographer in augmenting the text historical verification and editorial decisions a detailed bibliographic essay adds a wealth of well researched data **Nisei Soldiers Break Their Silence** Linda Tamura,2012-12-15 Nisei Soldiers Break Their Silence is a compelling story of courage community endurance and reparation It shares the experiences of Japanese Americans Nisei who served in the U S Army during World War II fighting on the front lines in Italy and France serving as linguists in the South Pacific and working as cooks and medics The soldiers were from Hood River Oregon where their families were landowners and fruit growers Town leaders including veterans groups attempted to prevent their return after the war and stripped their names from the local war memorial All of the soldiers were American citizens but their parents were Japanese immigrants and had been imprisoned in camps as a consequence of Executive Order 9066 The racist homecoming that the Hood River Japanese American soldiers received was decried across the nation Linda Tamura who grew up in Hood River and whose father was a veteran of the war conducted extensive oral histories with the veterans their families and members of the community She had access to hundreds of recently uncovered letters and documents from private files of a local veterans group that led the campaign against the Japanese American soldiers This book also includes the little known story of local Nisei veterans who spent 40 years appealing their convictions for insubordination Watch the book trailer <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hHMcFdmixLk> **Mine Okubo** Greg Robinson,Elena Tajima Creef,2018-07-01 To me life and art are one and the same for the key lies in one s knowledge of people and life In art one is trying to express it in the simplest imaginative way as in the art of past civilizations for beauty and truth are the only two things which live timeless and ageless Min Okubo This is the first book length critical examination of the life and work of Min Okubo 1912-2001 a pioneering Nisei artist writer and social activist who repeatedly defied conventional role expectations for women and for Japanese Americans over her seventy year career Okubo s landmark Citizen 13660 first published in 1946 is the first and arguably best known autobiographical narrative of the wartime Japanese American relocation and confinement experience Born in Riverside California Okubo was incarcerated by the U S government during World War II first at the Tanforan Assembly Center in California and later at the Topaz War Relocation Center in Utah There she taught art and directed the production of a literary and art magazine While in camp Okubo documented her confinement experience by making hundreds of paintings and pen and ink sketches These provided the



material for *Citizen 13660* Word of her talent spread to *Fortune* magazine which hired her as an illustrator Under the magazine's auspices she was able to leave the camp and relocate to New York City where she pursued her art over the next half century This lovely and inviting book lavishly illustrated with both color and halftone images many of which have never before been reproduced introduces readers to Okubo's oeuvre through a selection of her paintings drawings illustrations and writings from different periods of her life In addition it contains tributes and essays on Okubo's career and legacy by specialists in the fields of art history education women's studies literature American political history and ethnic studies essays that illuminate the importance of her contributions to American arts and letters Min Okubo expands the sparse critical literature on Asian American women as well as that on the Asian American experience in the eastern United States It also serves as an excellent companion to *Citizen 13660* providing critical tools and background to place Okubo's work in its historical and literary contexts

**Judgment Without Trial** Tetsuden Kashima, 2011-10-17 2004 Washington State Book Award Finalist *Judgment without Trial* reveals that long before the 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor the U.S. government began making plans for the eventual internment and later incarceration of the Japanese American population Tetsuden Kashima uses newly obtained records to trace this process back to the 1920s when a nascent imprisonment organization was developed to prepare for a possible war with Japan and follows it in detail through the war years Along with coverage of the well known incarceration camps the author discusses the less familiar and very different experiences of people of Japanese descent in the Justice and

War Departments internment camps that held internees from the continental U S and from Alaska Hawaii and Latin America Utilizing extracts from diaries contemporary sources official communications and interviews Kashima brings an array of personalities to life on the pages of his book those whose unbiased assessments of America s Japanese ancestry population were discounted or ignored those whose works and actions were based on misinformed fears and racial animosities those who tried to remedy the inequities of the system and by no means least the prisoners themselves Kashima s interest in this episode began with his own unanswered questions about his father s wartime experiences From this very personal motivation he has produced a panoramic and detailed picture without rhetoric and emotionalism and supported at every step by documented fact of a government that failed to protect a group of people for whom it had forcibly assumed total responsibility
