Rewards to skill supply, skill demand and skill match-mismatch Richard Desjardins, 2014-03-28 This book is a collection of three independent but closely related studies The focus is on the potential causes of skill mismatch the extent of skill mismatch the socio demographic make up of skill mismatch and the consequences of skill mismatch in terms of earnings as well as employer sponsored adult education training A distinction is made between skill mismatch and education mismatch All three studies use data from the Adult Literacy and Lifeskills Survey ALLS to investigate the relationships between select outcomes and skill supply demand characteristics as well as their interactions which materialize into skill match mismatch situations The dataset contains direct measures of literacy skills as well as measures of the use of these skills at work which allow for a direct measure of literacy match mismatch.
