Portuguese Armenian or Assyrian etc In England and Bankstown 99% of my clients were the elderly the greatest percentage were of English or Anglo Australian background but also of many other nationalities and ethnic backgrounds So there have been cases relating to family relationship children marital problems psychiatric problems immigration needing information on a large range of subjects health death work financial problems sexual problems etc and cultural differences But first I was a Social Work Student
