

and Dorothy Richardson Though Bishop criticized Woolf she in particular is treated as a central and thus far neglected precursor crucial to our understanding of Bishop as a feminist poet Finally the sustained discussion of how the history of prose frames effects of rhythm syntax and acoustic texture in both Bishop s prose proper and her prosaic verse extends a body of research which seeks now to treat literature as a form of cognition Technique and thought are finely wedded in Bishop s work her literary forms evince a historical intelligence attuned to questions of power nationality tradition both literary and otherwise race and gender **Degrees of Freedom** Bethany Hicok,2008 In this original contribution to the history of American poetry in the 20th century Bethany Hicok traces the influence of the women s college on the poetic development of three American poets Marianne Moore at Bryn Mawr Elizabeth Bishop at Vassar and Sylvia Plath at Smith
