Lincoln in November 1864 and the increasing number of deserters from the Confederate lines only confirmed the growing belief among the soldiers in the trenches that Union victory was inevitable Taken together these aspects of the Petersburg experience mitigated the negative effects of trench warfare and allowed men to adapt more easily to their new world of combat Sodergren explores the many factors that enabled the Army of the Potomac to endure the brutal physical conditions of trench warfare and emerge with a renewed sense of purpose as fighting resumed on the open battlefield in 1865 Drawing from soldiers letters and diaries official military correspondence and court martial records he paints a vivid picture of the daily lives of Union soldiers as they witnessed the beginnings of a profound shift in the way the world imagined and waged large scale warfare
