conclusions are consonant with Dostoevsky's work freedom is constitutive for the being or the mode of being essence of man it is an inalienable duty one must become oneself Man strives to overcome himself and to exceed his freedom but in so doing invariably loses it Man exceeds himself only in the sense that he realizes an ideal human possibility.
