La importancia de Fedro siglo I d.C. como en otro tiempo la de Esopo reside en haber elevado la fábula hasta el momento presente como ingrediente auxiliar en otros géneros literarios como la sátira y el verso literario autónomo. Consciente de que su obra es muy modesta y siendo un poeta menor elige un género humilde para convertirse en la voz de la protesta impotente de los débiles. Por lo demás aunque algunas de sus fábulas son traducciones de las de Esopo Fedro es un poeta original que amplia y contamina temas tradicionales creando fábulas totalmente nuevas que contienen elementos de crítica y de sátira contra la sociedad y la moral propias de la época Aviano siglos IV-V d.C. compuso cuarenta y dos fábulas en distintos estilos de menor valor literario que la de Fedro y de estilo más barroco la suya es una obra repleta de calcos lúxicos y simbólicos de los poetas clásicos. A diferencia de Fedro gozó de inmensa fortuna en la Edad Media.

Aunque los nombres de Fedro y Aviano han conocido peor fortuna que el de Esopo sus fábulas han servido de modelo tanto a los fabulistas posteriores como a escritores de otros géneros que las incluyen en sus obras. Género abierto popular folclórico y de difícil definición la fábula ha estado presente en casi todas las culturas. En muchos pueblos la tradición fabulística se organizaba en torno a un supuesto autor legendario o semilegendario como Esopo en Grecia publicado también en Biblioteca Clásica Gredos. En Roma sin embargo encontramos ya autores reales de cuya existencia efectiva no cabe duda. El primero de ellos es Fedro (15 a.C. - 55 d.C.) cuyo centenar de leyendas y fábulas ha llegado hasta nosotros dividido en cinco libros y un índice con treinta y dos fábulas más probablemente también del autor Fedro que califica sus fábulas de espirituosas no es sin embargo un mero imitador de Esopo pues se separa de este en el estilo y en los temas y muchos de sus relatos son originales. Hijo expósito esclavo manumitido por Augusto Fedro se refiere muy a menudo a las injusticias sociales. Sus fábulas tienen el doble propósito de aconsejar y entretenerte y suelen ser de tono grave algunas de ellas son muy conocidas aún hoy como El lobo
