Carr, 2011-10-12 In *The Formation of the Hebrew Bible* David Carr rethinks both the methods and historical orientation points for research into the growth of the Hebrew Bible into its present form Building on his prior work *Writing on the Tablet of the Heart* Oxford 2005 he explores both the possibilities and limits of reconstruction of pre stages of the Bible The method he advocates is a methodologically modest investigation of those pre stages utilizing criteria and models derived from his survey of documented examples of textual revision in the Ancient Near East The result is a new picture of the formation of the Hebrew Bible with insights on the initial emergence of Hebrew literary textuality the development of the first Hexateuch and the final formation of the Hebrew Bible Where some have advocated dating the bulk of the Hebrew Bible in a single period whether relatively early Neo Assyrian or late Persian or Hellenistic Carr uncovers specific evidence that the Hebrew Bible contains texts dating across Israelite history even the early pre exilic period 10th 9th centuries He traces the impact of Neo Assyrian imperialism on eighth and seventh century Israelite textuality He uses studies of collective trauma to identify marks of the reshaping and collection of traditions in response to the destruction of Jerusalem and Babylonian exile He develops a picture of varied Priestly reshaping of narrative and prophetic traditions in the Second Temple period including the move toward eschatological and apocalyptic themes and genres And he uses manuscript evidence from Qumran and the Septuagint to find clues to the final literary shaping of the proto Masoretic text likely under the Hasmonean monarchy **The Dawn of Apocalyptic** Paul D. Hanson, 1979 In challenging both traditional and contemporary notions of the nature and history of the Biblical apocalyptic literature Professor Hanson begins by saying that the origins of apocalyptic cannot be explained by a method which juxtaposes seventh and second century compositions and then proceeds to account for the features of the latter by reference to its immediate environment The apocalyptic literature of the second century and after is the result of a long development reaching back to pre exilic times and beyond and not the new baby of second century foreign parents Not only the sources of origin but the intrinsic nature of late apocalyptic compositions can be understood only by tracing the centuries long development through which the apocalyptic eschatology developed from prophetic and other even more archaic native roots In this ground breaking study Professor Hanson focuses on one strand which can be seen running through the heart of many of the so called apocalyptic works the strand of apocalyptic eschatology He seeks to demonstrate that the rise of apocalyptic eschatology is

neither sudden nor anomalous but follows the pattern of an unbroken development from preexilic and exilic prophecy **A Theology of the Old Testament** John L. Linguistic Evidence for the Pre-exilic Date of the Yahwistic Source Rick Wright, 2005-05-01 For the past few decades a growing number of scholars have attempted to overthrow the traditional Wellhausen view that the so called Yahwist or J source of the Pentateuch is the oldest of the four major sources These scholars have argued that J was composed during the exilic or post exilic periods of ancient Israel Their arguments have focused on the literary historiographic and theological characteristics of J This book attempts to re evaluate on linguistic grounds such efforts to place the Yahwist source in the exilic or post exilic periods The study employs the methodology developed most prominently by Avi Hurvitz for identifying characteristic features of post exilic Hebrew Late Biblical Hebrew This divides the language of the Hebrew Bible into three main chronological stages Archaic Biblical Hebrew ABH Standard Biblical Hebrew SBH and Late Biblical Hebrew LBH Wright examines 40 features of J for which useful comparisons can be made to LBH and finds no evidence of LBH in the entire Yahwist source Therefore it is unlikely that J was composed during the post exilic period Moreover since Hurvitz has shown that the exilic period was a time of transition between SBH and LBH such that late features began to occur in exilic texts the author concludes on linguistic grounds that J was most likely composed during the pre exilic period of ancient Israel
