

The preferred model is a dynamic model of incomplete competition which is evaluated against alternatives as diverse as the Phillips curve Nickell Layard wage curves the New Keynesian Phillips curve and monetary inflation models on data from the Euro area the UK and Norway The wage price core model is built into a small econometric model for Norway to analyse the transmission mechanism and to evaluate monetary policy rules The final chapter explores the main sources of forecast failure likely to occur in a practical modelling situation using the large scale nodel RIMINI and the inflation models of earlier chapters as case studies A History of Macroeconometric Model-building Ronald G.
