

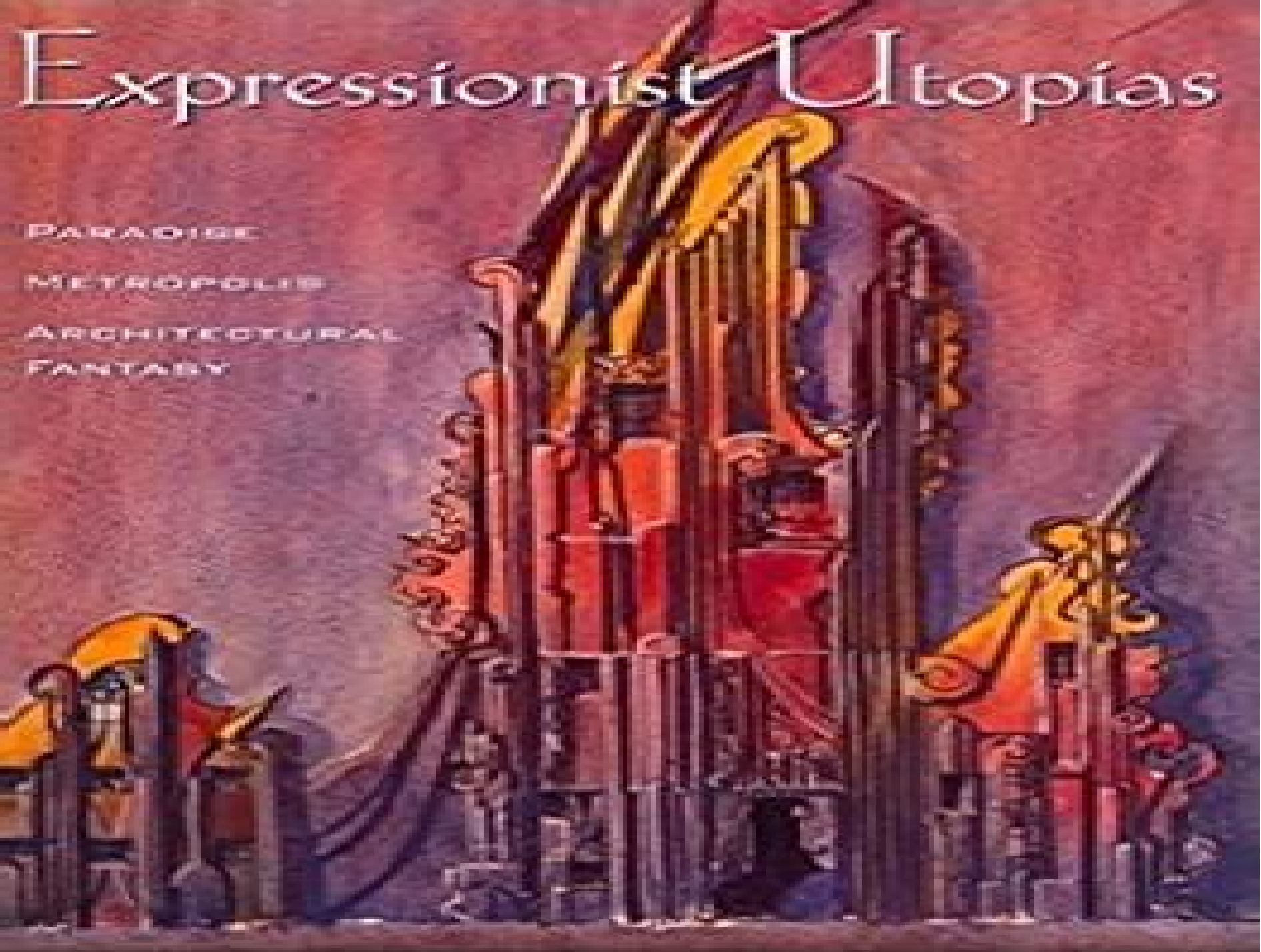

Benson, David Frisby, 1993 The notion of utopia exists in every culture capturing shared dreams and common goals This book prepared to accompany the exhibition *Expressionist Utopias* mounted at the Los Angeles County Museum in 1993 explores how the optimistic themes of utopia and fantasy sustained faith among artists and architects in the power of art to shape a better world during the tumultuous World War I era in Germany The exhibition's curator Timothy O Benson along with David Frisby Reinhold Heller Anton Kaes Wolf Prix and Iain Boyd White present the diverse manifestations of the utopia metaphor in its progression throughout Expressionism from Arcadian to manmade utopias This work includes a new essay and an interview by Edward Dimenbergh with Wolf Prix on the spectacular installation created for the exhibition by the Viennese architectural firm Coop Himmelblau **Avant-Garde World Creation** Abigail van Alst, 2025-10-30 This book explores the widespread fascination with world creation among early twentieth century artists and examines those trends within the European avant garde The book reflects on what the world looks and feels like before and after World War One and thus also concerns creativity and destruction alike in the context of modernity Over the course of three chapters the author focusses on works in which avant garde artists combine and experiment with various arts and media to create alternative narratives of the world's creation These works include three canonized total works of art *Der Weltbaumeister* The World's Master Builder 1920 an illustrated book imagined as an architectural play by the Expressionist architect Bruno Taut the Futurist opera *C Victory Over the Sun* 1913 by Aleksei Kruchenykh Velimir Khlebnikov Kazimir Malevich and Mikhail Matiushin and the Cubist ballet *La Création du monde* The Creation of the World 1923 by Blaise Cendrars Fernand Léger Darius Milhaud and Jean Bérlioz Providing new readings of these classic works that dive deeply into the avant garde's inter artistic search for new modes of mediation as well as its dialogue with science politics and technology Abigail van Alst demonstrates how each of these artworks staged a cosmogony an alternative story of the universe's creation which simultaneously experimentally and critically recounted the story of modernity This new book is ideal for researchers and scholars in History of Art Modernism and Comparative Literature **Acrobatic Modernism from the Avant-Garde to Prehistory** Jed Rasula, 2020-02-27 This is a book about artistic modernism contending with the historical transfigurations of modernity As a conscientious engagement with modernity's restructuring of the lifeworld the modernist avant garde raised the stakes of this engagement to programmatic explicitness But even beyond the vanguard the global phenomenon of jazz combined somatic assault with sensory tutelage Jazz like the new technologies of modernity recalibrated sensory ratios The criterion of the new as self-making also extended to names pseudonyms and heteronyms The protocols of modernism solicited a pragmatic arousal of bodily sensation as artistic resource validating an acrobatic sensibility ranging from slapstick and laughter to the pathos of bereavement Expressivity trumped representation The artwork was a diagram of perception not

a mimetic rendering For artists the historical pressures of altered perception provoked new models and Ezra Pound's slogan Make It New became the generic rallying cry of renovation The paradigmatic stance of the avant garde was established by Futurism but the discovery of prehistoric art added another provocation to artists Paleolithic caves validated the spirit of all over composition unframed and dynamic Geometric abstraction Constructivism and Purism and Surrealism were all in quest of a new mythology Making it new yielded a new pathos in the sensation of radical discrepancy between futurist striving and remotest antiquity The Paleolithic cave and the USSR emitted comparable siren calls on behalf of the remote past and the desired future As such the present was suffused with the pathos of being neither but subject to both

H. G. Wells, Modernity and the Movies Keith Williams, 2007-12-01 This book investigates Wells's interest in cinema and related media technologies by placing it back into the contemporary cultural and scientific contexts giving rise to them It plugs a gap in understanding Wells's contribution to exploring and advancing the possibilities of cinematic narrative and its social and ideological impacts in the modern period Previous studies concentrate on adaptations this book accounts for the specifically proto cinematic techniques and concerns of Wells's texts It also focuses on contemporary film making in dialogue with his ideas Alongside Hollywood's later transactions it gives equal weight to neglected British and continental European dimensions Chapter 1 shows how early writings *The Time Machine* and short stories feature many kinds of radically defamiliarised vision These constitute imaginative speculations about the forms and potentials of moving image and electronic media Chapter 2 discusses the power of voyeurism absent presence and the disjunction of sound image reproduction implied in *The Invisible Man* and its topical politics updated in notable screen versions Chapter 3 extends this to dystopian warnings of systematic surveillance broadcasting of celebrity personae and post literate video culture in *When the Sleeper Wakes* a crucial template for urban futures on film Chapter 4 analyses Wells's belated return to screenwriting in the 1930s It accounts for his broadbrow ambition of mediating between popular and avant garde tendencies to promote his cause and its mixed results in *Things to Come* *The Man Who Could Work Miracles* etc Chapter 5 finally surveys Wells's legacy on both small and large screens It considers whether as well as being raided for scenarios for spectacular effects his

subtexts still nourish an evolving tradition of alternative SF which duly critiques the innovations and applications of its host media

Edgar G. Ulmer Noah Isenberg, 2024-09-03 Edgar G Ulmer is perhaps best known today for *Detour* considered by many to be the epitome of a certain noir style that transcends its B list origins But in his lifetime he never achieved the celebrity of his fellow Austrian and German migr directors Billy Wilder Otto Preminger Fred Zinnemann and Robert Siodmak Despite early work with Max Reinhardt and F W Murnau his auspicious debut with Siodmak on their celebrated Weimar classic *People on Sunday* and the success of films like *Detour* and *Ruthless* Ulmer spent most of his career as an itinerant filmmaker earning modest paychecks for films that have either been overlooked or forgotten In this fascinating and well researched account of a career spent on the margins of Hollywood Noah Isenberg provides the little known details of Ulmer's personal life and a thorough analysis of his wide ranging eclectic films features aimed at minority audiences horror and sci fi flicks genre pictures made in the U S and abroad Isenberg shows that Ulmer's unconventional path was in many ways more typical than that of his more famous colleagues As he follows the twists and turns of Ulmer's fortunes Isenberg also conveys a new understanding of low budget filmmaking in the studio era and beyond

Art of Suppression Pamela M. Potter, 2016-06-28 This provocative study asks why we have held on to vivid images of the Nazis total control of the visual and performing arts even though research has shown that many artists and their works thrived under Hitler To answer this question Pamela M Potter investigates how historians since 1945 have written about music art architecture theater film and dance in Nazi Germany and how their accounts have been colored by politics of the Cold War the fall of communism and the wish to preserve the idea that true art and politics cannot mix Potter maintains that although the persecution of Jewish artists and other enemies of the state was a high priority for the Third Reich removing them from German cultural life did not eradicate their artistic legacies *Art of Suppression* examines the cultural histories of Nazi Germany to help us understand how the circumstances of exile the Allied occupation the Cold War and the complex meanings of modernism have sustained a distorted and problematic characterization of cultural life during the Third Reich

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
