The solemnity and seriousness of the epic led almost inevitably to parody and burlesque This is how mock heroic or mock epic poetry was born One of the best examples in English is Alexander Pope s The Rape of the Lock The tale in verse Narrative in verse was very popular during the Renaissance and met great favour again in the Romantic period thanks to Walter Scott who started his career as a poet and George Byron The romance The medieval romance was a tale in verse dealing with chivalry and love Edmund Spencer's Faerie Queene and Alfred Tennyson's Idylls of the king are modeled on the medieval chivaltric romance Dramatic poetry.
