

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1968 (ESEA) was an extraordinary landmark in the history of American education. For the first time in over a century of attempts to legislate federal general aid to education, Congress took positive action toward solving the greatest problems facing this country—poverty and ignorance, both rooted in the inequalities of the American education system.

This book is a study in public administration. It is the story of the role played by the U.S. Office of Education, an agency of previously minor importance, in developing and administering Public Law 89-10 (ESEA). The new law, with its massive infusion of funds and authority, demanded a strong agency, courageous leaders, and a new outlook.

The time of this case study covers two years—spring of 1964 to spring of 1966. Extended interviews and extensive readings are the base of the study.

Following a scholarly first chapter on the historical setting, the authors pitch right into the politics of the passage of Public Law 89-10. The Democratic landslide of November 1964, President Johnson's interest in improving educational quality and opportunity, and Democratic majorities in both the Senate and the House all contributed to a favorable political climate. Francis Keppel, Commissioner of Education, played a key role as an intermediary broker of ideas.

"A package format of five separate titles for the bill was one of the devices employed by the architects of ESEA to grant a variety of benefits, while denying to each protagonist his full range of demands."

Title I, Better Schooling for Educationally Deprived Children, accounted for five-sixths of the total funds authorized for ESEA. It "offered an ingenious balance of power among levels of government, an interweaving of specific and ambiguous program parameters, and a mingling of short- and long-range objectives. Even so, its authors concluded that it alone would fully satisfy neither
