This book includes most of the contributions presented at a conference on Universities and Science in the Early Modern Period held in 1999 in Valencia Spain. The conference was part of the Five Centuries of the Life of the University of Valencia Cinc Segles celebrations and from the outset we had the generous support of the Patronato Foundation overseeing the events. In recent decades as a result of a renewed attention to the institutional political social and cultural context of scientific activity we have witnessed a reappraisal of the role of the universities in the construction and development of early modern science. In essence the following conclusions have been reached 1 the attitudes regarding scientific progress or novelty differed from country to country and follow different trajectories in the course of the early modern period 2 institutions of higher learning were the main centers of education for most scientists 3 although the universities were sometimes slow to assimilate new scientific knowledge when they did so it helped not only to remove the suspicion that the new science was intellectually subversive but also to make science a respectable and even prestigious activity 4 the universities gave the scientific movement considerable material support in the form of research facilities such as anatomical theaters botanical gardens and expensive instruments 5 the universities provided professional employment and a means of support to many scientists and 6 although the relations among the universities and the academies or scientific societies were sometimes antagonistic the two types of institutions often worked together in harmony performing complementary rather than competing functions moreover individuals moved from one institution to another as did knowledge methods and scientific practices
