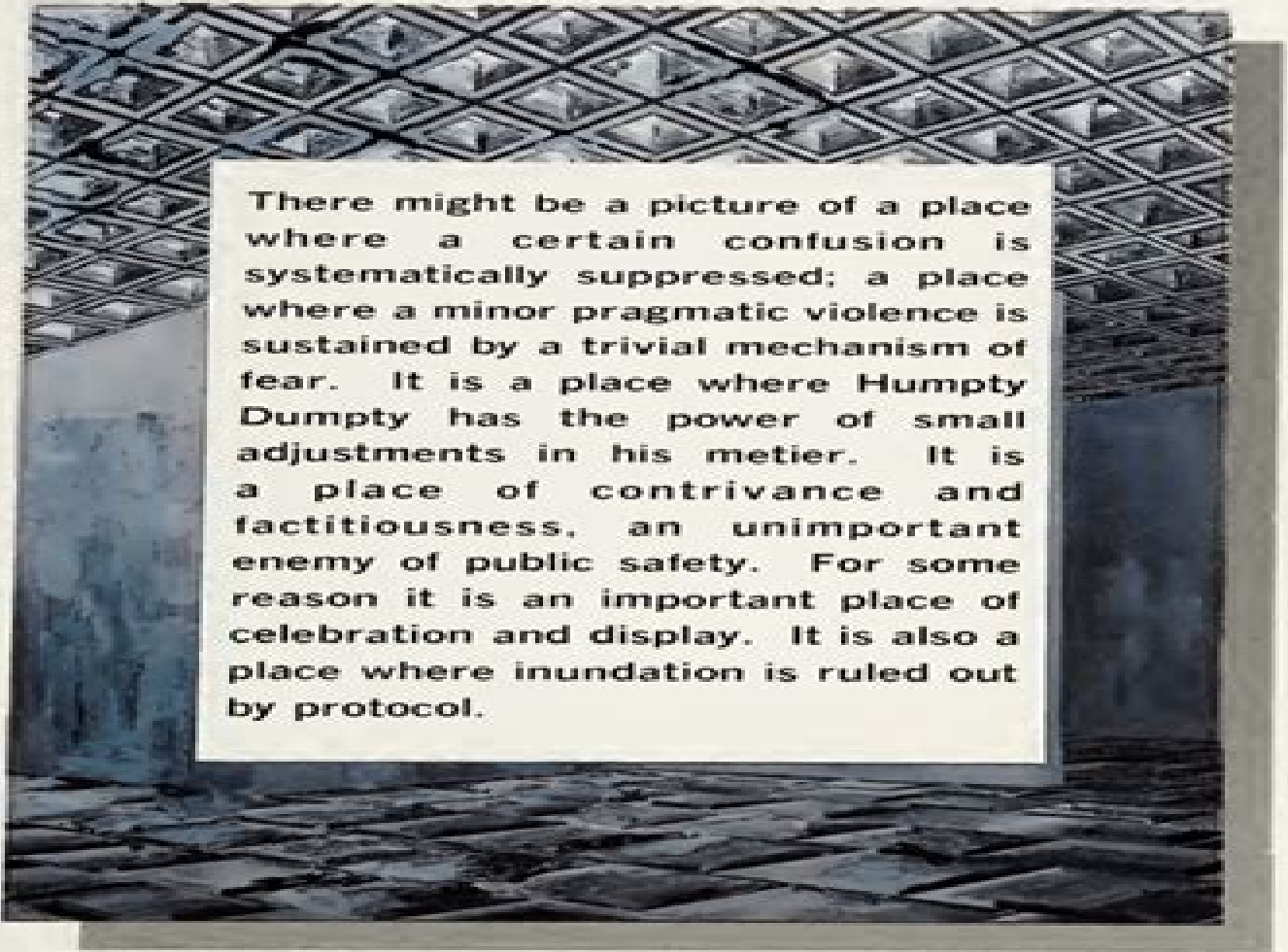

Rather, Fred Orton self-consciously constructs a Jasper Johns whose work is introduced and explained in three chapters, each of which addresses a specific picture or sculpture like *Flag Painted Bronze*, *Savarin*, and *Untitled* 1992. These in-depth studies situate individual works in their social context as well as in Johns's oeuvre. Fred Orton's purpose is to get to terms with and find terms for a difficult and elusive body of work by one of the most important artists of the 20th century.

A Show of Hands Ileana Parvu, 2024-12-13 In contrast to the divide between conception and execution advocated by Anglo American artists in the second half of the 1960s this book reappraises conceptual art by examining it from the perspective of craft The emphasis on craft shifts the focus from the Western art system to its margins where creators were relegated to the status of mere artisans in the colonial context on the pretext that attaining that of artists was beyond their reach From this peripheral point of view the book shows that work carried out with artisanal means can lead to conceptual practice Moreover this shift in perspective provides a new understanding of several positions within conceptualism which ultimately appears as an ongoing reflection on the role of the hands making and craft Look inside

Abstraction in Post-War British Literature 1945-1980 Natalie Ferris, 2022-03-29 In a catalogue note for the 1965 exhibition *Between Poetry and Painting* at the Institute of Contemporary Arts the poet Edwin Morgan probed the relationship between abstraction and literature Abstract painting can often satisfy but abstract poetry can only exist in inverted commas Language may be fragmented rearranged or distorted abstract in so far as it is withdrawn from a particular system of knowledge but Morgan was of the mind that to be wholly disruptive was to deprive a poem of its point as an object of contemplation Whilst abstract art may have come to fulfil or fortify an impression of post war taste abstraction in literature continued to be treated with suspicion But how does this speak to the extent to which Britain's literary culture was responsive to progress compared to its artistic culture *Abstraction in Post War British Literature 1945 1980* traces a line of literary experimentation in post war British literature that was prompted by the aesthetic philosophical and theoretical demands of abstraction

Spanning the period 1945 to 1980 it observes the ways in which certain aesthetic advancements initiated new forms of literary expression to posit a new genealogy of interdisciplinary practice in Britain At a time in which Britain became conscious of its evolving identity within an increasingly globalised context this study accounts for the range of Continental and Transatlantic influences in order to more accurately locate the networks at play Exploring the contributions made by individuals such as Herbert Read Ian Hamilton Finlay and Christine Brooke Rose as well as by groups of practitioners It brings a wide range of previously unexplored archival material into the public domain and offers a comprehensive account of the evolving status of abstraction across cultural institutional and literary contexts

Positioning himself in the slippery divide between two highly charged critical approaches deconstruction and cultural studies J Hillis Miller explains why the split occurred and offers for the first time an eloquent analysis of the goals and methods of cultural studies Miller's Illustration is an intellectual adventure that transgresses the boundaries of critical theory to reveal the ideological forces at work The result art critic Norman Bryson concludes is an extraordinary performance In a positive constructive way Miller describes cultural studies as primarily a means of contextualizing works of art Relating the assumptions behind this approach to recent social political and technological changes he shows how cultural studies is itself subject to its context and thus perhaps misguided insofar as it portrays art objects as mere illustration In particular Miller considers new forms of electronic research in the humanities which with their vast homogenizing effect on data can compel a critic to reconfigure information in fact to create the context that he or she means simply to identify To illustrate this phenomenon Miller investigates one topic of importance for cultural studies the relation of verbal and visual forms in multimedia works Drawing examples from Twain Gorey Mallarme James Ruskin Heidegger Dickens and Turner he shows how neither word nor image takes priority in such collaborations nor is either a mere representation of a pre-existing reality The transformations wrought by cultural artifacts on their contexts Miller contends must be identified through detailed and vigilant rhetorical readings if the force of a work of art is to be passed on into the current cultural situation And for the new form these readings take the reader critic must in turn assume responsibility Death of the Artist Nicola
