Center Redevelopment Project Arizona's first major urban renewal project which targeted the most densely populated eighty acres in the state. For close to one hundred years Tucsonenses had created their own spatial reality in the historical predominantly Mexican American heart of the city an area most called *la calle*. Here amid small retail and service shops restaurants and entertainment venues they openly lived and celebrated their culture. To make way for the Pueblo Center's new buildings city officials proceeded to displace *la calle*'s residents and to demolish their ethnically diverse neighborhoods which contends Lydia Otero challenged the spatial and cultural assumptions of postwar modernity suburbia and urban planning. Otero examines conflicting claims to urban space place and history as advanced by two opposing historic preservationist groups the La Placita Committee and the Tucson Heritage Foundation.
