A New Initiative for an Established Program

In 1981, the Congress of the United States approved the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act that, among other things, allowed states to assume administrative responsibility for the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Since its inception in 1975, the program had been lodged in he U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and had grown to become the second largest source of federal assistance to nonmetropolitan areas. Its primary objectives were to create viable housing and living environments and to expand economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income. By giving the states the authority to distribute federal dollars under state-devised guidelines, Congress put state officials in control of the Small Cities decision-making process and effectively reduced HUD's role to overseeing only the program's national goals. Thirty-six states and Puerto Rico opted to take charge of the Small Cities program in 1982; in 1983, ten additional states assumed control of the program, leaving only Hawaii, Kansas, Maryland, and New York under HUD administration.

This intergovernmental transfer of policy control was part of a broader set of actions designed to implement President Ronald Reagan's vision of a new federal-state relationship. Of the nine block grants created or revised by the 1981 Budget Act, only the CDBG program was a purely national to local grant; that is, for CDBG's first seven years, state governments were by-passed in the award process. For the other eight block grants, involving the areas of bealth services, social services, low-income home energy assistance, education, and community services, state governments had already gained considerable experience and influence. Equally important to the new policy approach for the CDBG program was its probationary nature the states had to meet certain conditions or else the program would
