in the 1840s and 1850s Unlike the impersonal business correspondence that makes up most fur trade writings Dawson s letters are wonderfully human suffused with raw emotion Combining careful research with a compelling story the authors flesh out the forces that shaped Dawson's personality and the historical events he recorded Hitler's Ostkrieg and the <u>Indian Wars</u> Edward B.
