

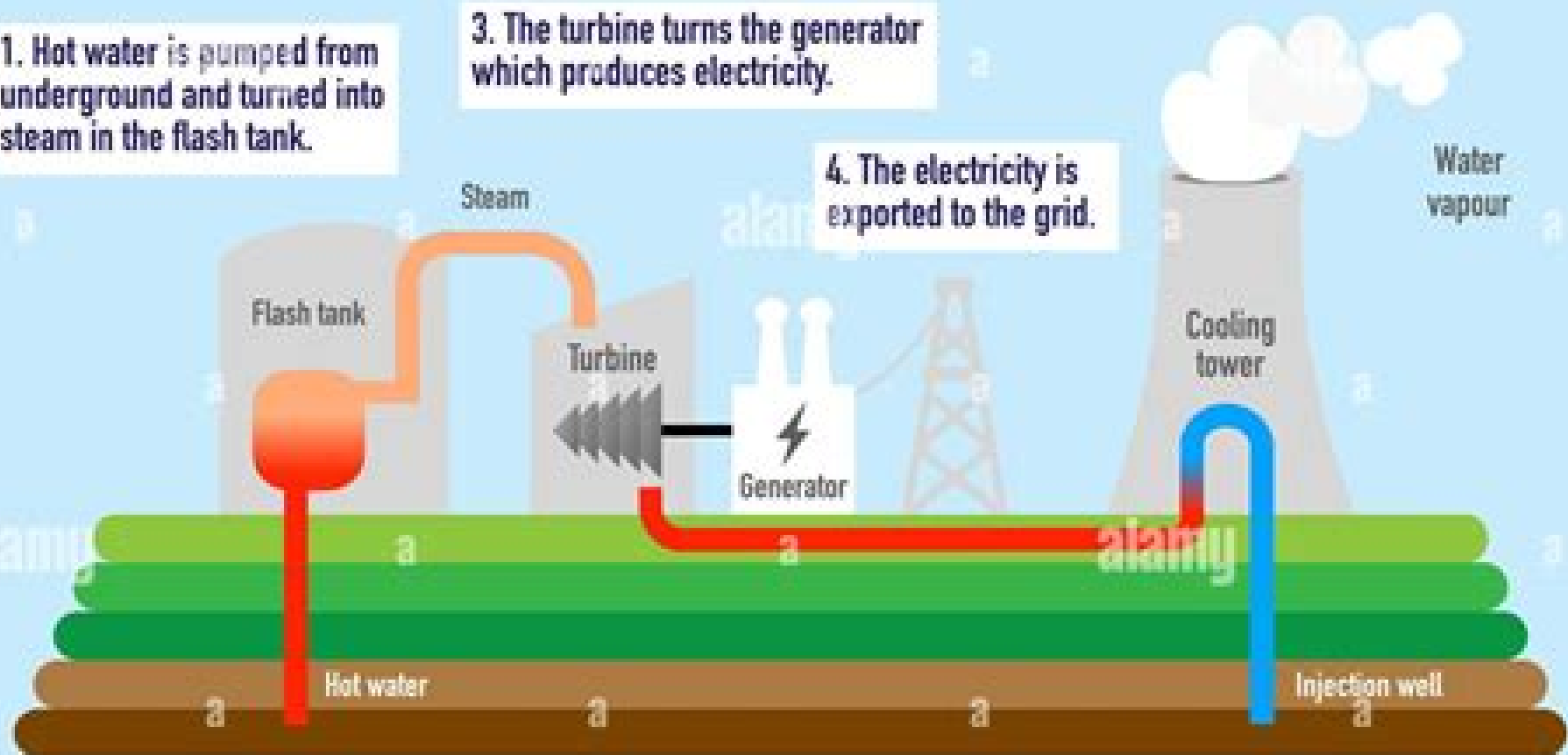
How geothermal power plants work
