George Crabbe Frank S. Whitehead,1995 *George Crabbe A Reappraisal* is centered on the belief that Crabbe particularly in his verse tales is an important even major poet whose work has been and still is seriously undervalued After an introductory chapter the next five chapters in Part 1 offer a straightforward account of the changes in Crabbe's poetry up to its pinnacle of achievement in 1812 tracing its development from the generalized discursive poetical essays of the 1780s through the particularized character sketches and anecdotes of *The Parish Register* and much of *The Borough* to the full length verse tales that reach their full maturity in *Tales* 1812
