An injury with a bow tie sign is not always a unitateral facet dislocation. Patient 58-Lateral mass fracture.

The lateral cervical spine radiograph shows double-diamonds (bow ties) at C3 and C4 (A and B,asterisks). There is also slight anterior slippage (anterolisthesis) of C4 on C5.

These findings are due to a fracture and rotational deformity of the right C4 lateral mass. C3 was rotated due to the injury at C4.
